### **CRISIS SIMULATION**

There shall be a crisis simulation at an undisclosed time. The nature and details of the crisis will be revealed during the conference and will be discussed and announced by the Secretariat. While it is up to the Council and the Foreign Affairs Ministers of each delegation to manage the crisis, the Committees will be tasked with certain aspects to work on. Indeed, it is important that the Council promptly tasks the appropriate Committees on aspects of the crisis which are best discussed in those Committees. This is one of the few opportunities the delegates have to directly collaborate with their colleagues from other Committees. The tasking of a Committee will be in writing. In all cases, the task takes precedence over all agenda items, including those currently under discussion in the Committee. There will be a set deadline, at which the Council must present their resolutions regarding the crisis.

### **ADDITIONAL AGENDA**

Delegates are encouraged to research other agenda items of interest to their country and to NATO and to propose these as additional agenda topics. Committee agenda shall be adopted at the first session of each Committee. While delegates are free to bring issues directly to the Secretariat and North Atlantic Council, they should be prepared to see them assigned to the relevant Committees for initial consideration. The Secretariat also reserve the right to change the Provisional Agenda at any time.
